Call to Order 6:30 pm

A roll call of Council Members showed all present.

Public Participation

Minutes of September 5, 2022, meeting. Motion to approve Hickey seconded Wibright unanimous approval

Fiscal Officer Report 09-19-22:

Check Register with checks from #56681 to #56723 and electronic warrants was provided to and signed by Council during the meeting.

Fund Balance Report through 09/19/22 was presented to Council at the meeting and emailed to Council after the meeting. Motion to accept the Fund Balance report was made by Jason Adelsberger and seconded by Scott Wilson. Motion passed unanimously.

Appropriation Measure 22-07 was presented to and discussed with Council. This included additional appropriations for expenses needed or anticipated for the remainder of 2022, including: payroll-related for General, Water, Sewer and Fire/EMS, as well as accounting for revenue and expense for \$19,000 in permissive tax funds held by the County and possible expenditure for Sewer UV Treatment, if approved. Motion to accept Appropriation Measure 22-07 was made by Jason Adelsberger and seconded by Scott Wilson. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Chip Wibright to allow Fiscal Officer to request \$19,000 in County-held Permissive Tax funds be disbursed to the Village to help fund the 2022 street paving project. Motion seconded by Chuck Foss. Motion passed unanimously.

Administrative Report

1. Scrap Tire Recycling and drive thru Flu Clinic October 15 9am-12pm, at the Champaign County Fairgrounds.
2. We have an estimate from Wiseman for the storm drain relocation at the Baptist Church. \$15,700. Possible cost share with the church due to addition.
3. Cameron has several estimates for sewer. The first has 2 estimates for replacing fencing at the sewer plant. Both are around \$7,500 for 200' of fence, gates and barbed wire. **Tabled.** There is also an estimate for UV treatment to be added at a cost of \$27,085.00. We have been having E coli violations on our outflow samplings this summer. **Tabled.**
4. I met with Steve and our Medicount representative to review billing. We have an old ordinance that allows us to bill \$75.00 for non-transport. Some commercial carriers allow up to \$400 to be billed. Medicare and Medicaid do not pay for non-transport. This would allow us to

possibly collect more fees. Also we can now bill for transporting care flight cases to the landing area.

Building

Grates were repaired in the fire bay. Still trying to get estimates on the roof at the street building.

Safety Chief Patrick is working on a no cost contract with the Goshen TWP to patrol the cemetery. Thanks to St Paris Police, North Lewisburg Police, Dispatch and all who helped with the Luke Bryant Concert traffic. Would like to have official mutual aid contracts with other Villages to help each other out. Would also like to have an impound lot on Mill St in the future.
