Call to Order – 6:30 pm

A roll call of Council Members showed all present.

Public Participation:

Sharon Trimble came to complain that the paving of the road did not meet her driveway. There is a 5ft gap between her driveway and the road. She brought pictures. Street Department will look into it.

Approval of Minutes: February 20, 2023, Motion was made to approve by Charles Hickey, seconded by Scott Wilson, motion passed unanimously.

Fiscal Officer Report- Fiscal Officer not available.

Village Administrator Report:

1. I met with Cooper about property on Mill St. I need to go to the Township meeting and discuss with offer for purchase of land. Need an amount and a motion.
2. Community clean-up is scheduled for May 6th. We need volunteers to help.
3. Approval to haul sludge for at least \$10,000. A motion was made to approve up to \$15,000 to haul sludge by Adelsberger and a second by Wibright with all in favor.

Zoning Report: 2 bldg. additions were approved. Duncan Oil is inquiring about zoning uses for property on S Main St. The school is replacing bleachers. March 25th is the Regular Planning Commission Meeting.

Committee Reports:

- Safety-EMS has been chosen to do a survey by Medicare over the next 5 months. There is a 10% reduction in fees if they don't participate. It puts more work on Asst Chief Castle.

Executive Session: A motion was made by Wibright and a second by Hickey to go into Executive Session to discuss the purchase of property. Roll Call Vote: Tibbals yes, Adelsberger yes, Wilson yes, Foss yes, Wibright yes, Hickey yes.

A motion was made to go back into Regular Session by Adelsberger with a second by Hickey and a Roll Call Vote: Tibbals yes, Adelsberger yes, Wilson yes, Foss yes, Wibright yes, Hickey yes. No decisions were made.

A motion was made by Tibbals and a second by Hickey to allow Administrator to offer Goshen TWP up to \$8,000 for approximately 2 acres of property listed as 60 Mill St. All were in Favor.




Motion was made by Adelsberger to adjourn and seconded by Hickey, motion passed unanimously, 7:10 pm.



I, Chief David C. Patrick, II, am in possession of four (4) firearms that have been forfeited by the court and the final forfeiture date is listed below with the firearm make and model and serial number. I am requesting permission to sell the four firearms after final forfeiture date to Vance Outdoors for store credit. This store credit will be used by the department to purchase equipment from Vance Outdoors and reduce the overall cost to the village. These sales to Vance Outdoors are contingent on being post final forfeiture date 30 days after sentencing order or 30 day after all appellant rights being exhausted by the defendant. If appeal is filed then the firearm will not be sold.
