

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION # 25-07

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION'S APPROVAL TO TEMPORARILY REDUCE THE VILLAGE OF MECHANICSBURG 'S SHARE OF THE GENERAL FUND (INSIDE) PROPERTY TAX COLLECTION FROM 1.70 INSIDE MILLS TO 1.30 INSIDE MILLS FOR THE 2025 PROPERTY TAXES COLLECTED IN 2026.

The Legislative Council of the Village of Mechanicsburg, in Champaign County, Ohio met in regular session at the Village Services Building, located at 18 N. Main St. in Mechanicsburg Ohio on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November, 2025, at the regular meeting with the following members present: Chip Wibright, Charles Hickey, Chuck Foss, Lori Tibbles, Billy Cobb, and Scott Wilson,

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Mechanicsburg , has determined that due to the financial stability of the general fund, and due to the increase in revenue resulting from the 2025 Revaluation of Real Property; to reduce the Village's share of the tax burden to taxpayers in the district for one year, and

WHEREAS, this one-year reduction on the collection is expected to reduce the property owners' tax bill;

THEREFORE, the Village of Mechanicsburg would not collect from property owners 0.4 inside mills in calendar year 2026 (tax year 2025). Any other tax liabilities such as school levies, other political subdivision levies, other political subdivision levies, ditch assessments, etc. would still be colledistributed to the appropriate taxing authority.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Village of Mechanicsburg, hereby seeks approval by the Champaign County Budget Commission to consider such request in an effort to reduce the burden on the taxpayers of Champaign County..
